DMG have funded a fluoride research study with their product Flairese. The children of the 2 schools in Mufelin have been screened and the fluoride applied. We will monitor the children every 3 months and record the changes (if any) in their oral health. This will be carried out over 2 years and we aim to use the research to help future .

We will also submit the research to the International Association for Dental Research.
